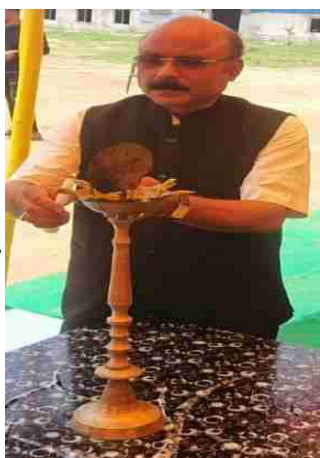

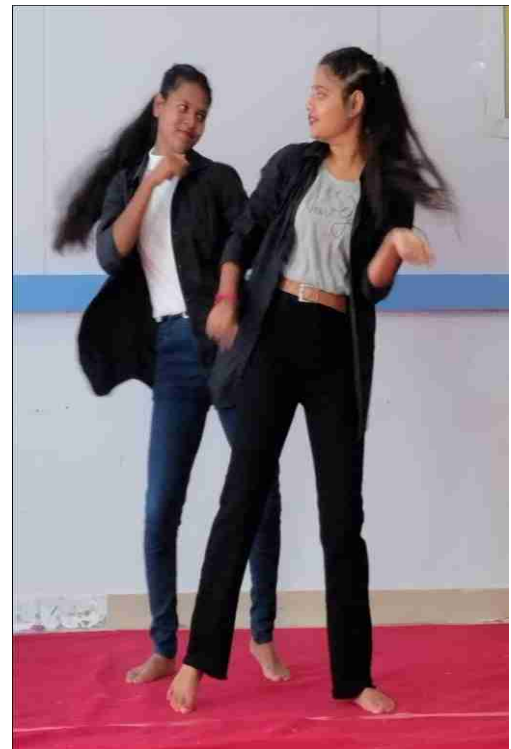


NSS PROGRAMME

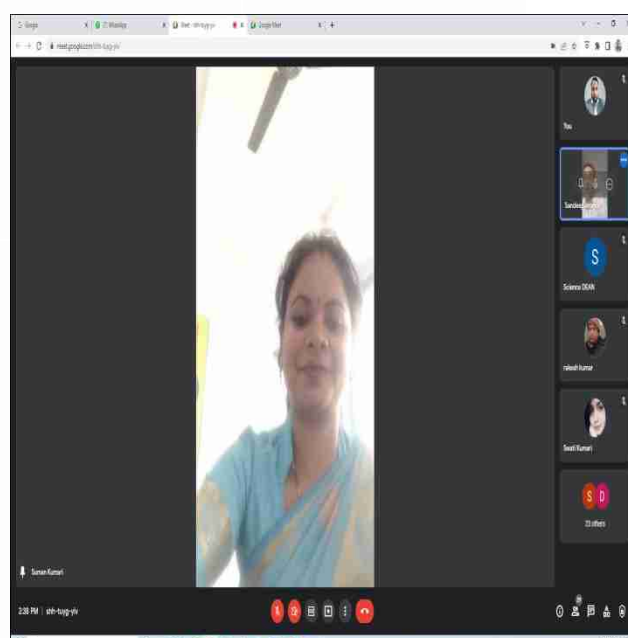
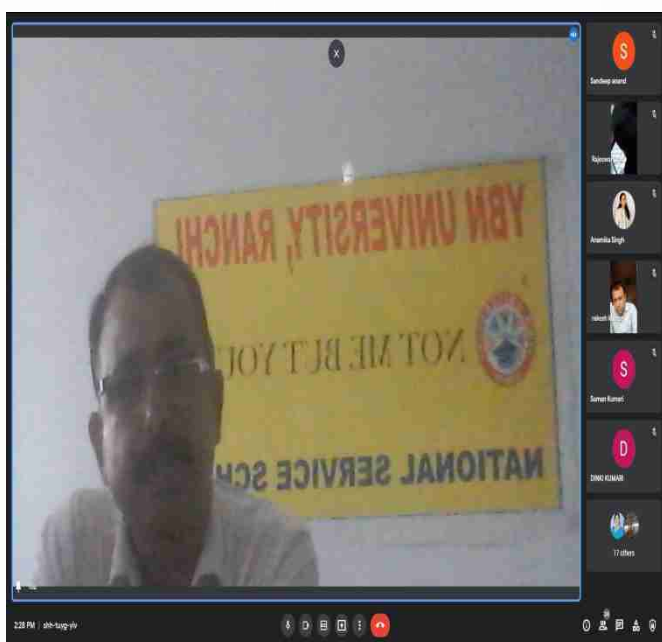


NSS-Yoga Workshop cum Lecture Series

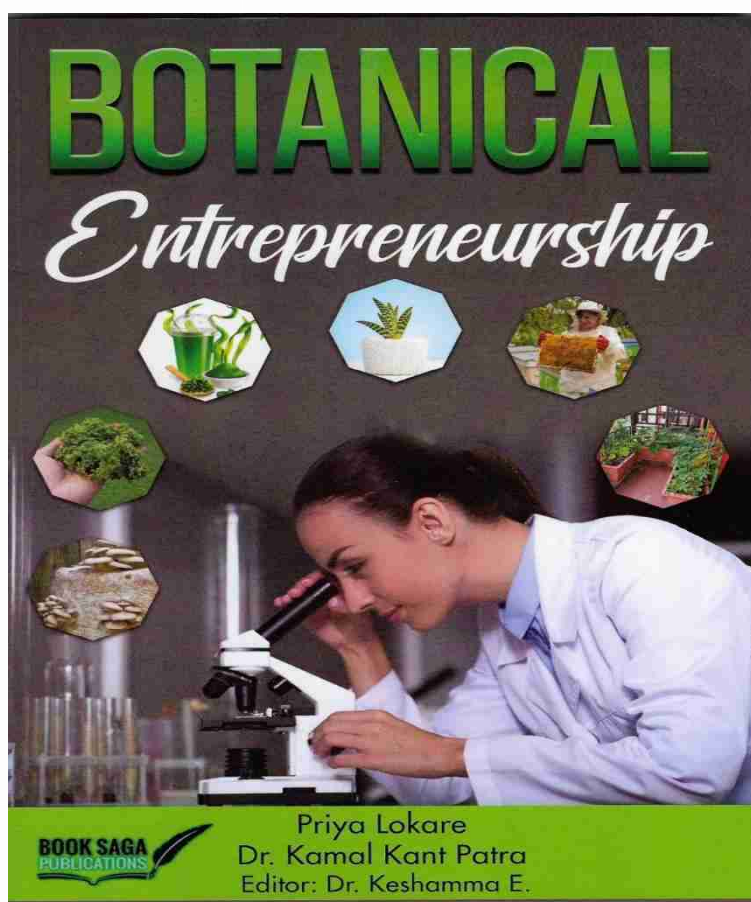
APRATYAKSHA- A Collection of Poems

BOTANICAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP

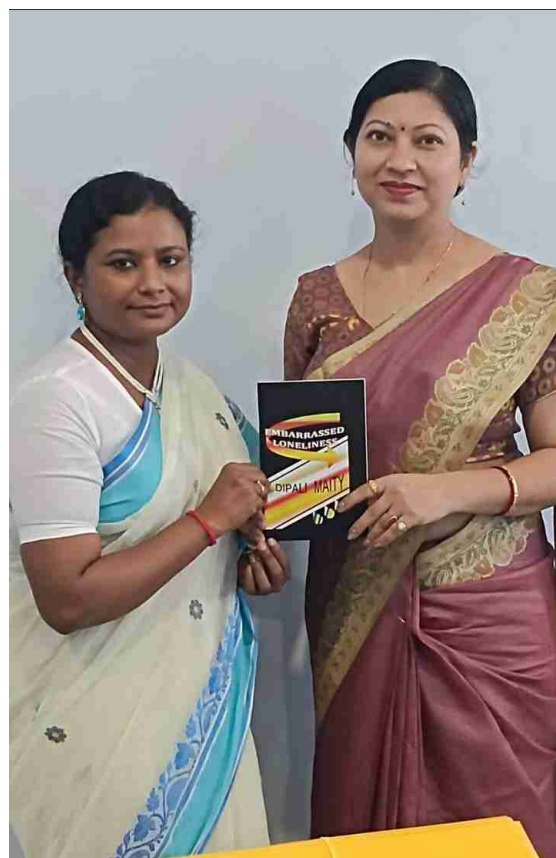

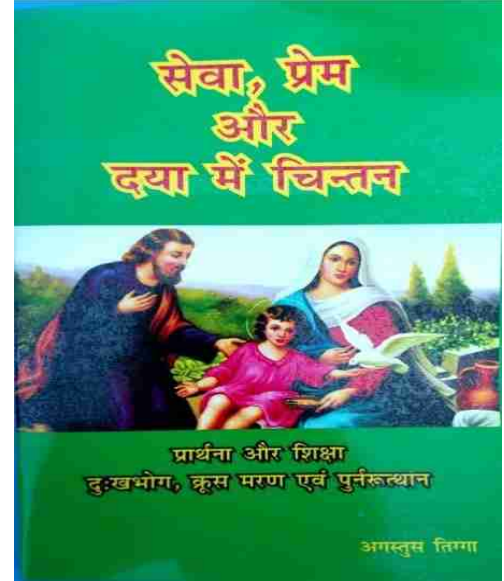

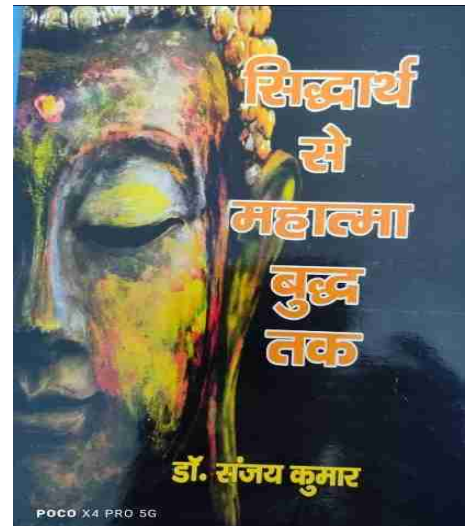
SEVA, PREM AUR DAYA MEIN CHINTAN

CHUTNIFICATION



The English language, now no more a foreign language, has taken India to global heights and has brought laurels to the brilliance of the Indian genius. While the English language has largely contributed to India's new international status the reversal in the fortunes of the language too is witnessed by the country. Chutnification the word viral nowadays has the quality to attract the attention of the readers. Historically, the English language was introduced in our country with the advent of British. This language came in contact with indigenous people who reluctantly accepted it with local adaptations and additions. This new code which is no one's mother tongue and contains elements from numerous languages is called '**Pidgin**' and the process by which it happens is called '**Pidginisation**'. Being the only language of communication among a diverse group of people, the frequency of its use slowly increased as does the number of its speakers. Now, pidgin no longer remain confined to work place, it became the language of personal and informal interaction. It then passes on to the newer generation who learn the pidgin as their mother-tongue.

Moving forward let me tell you, the first major fiction writer to experiment with English language for writing fiction was Mulk Raj Anand with his novel '**Untouchable**'. Then came Raja Rao, R.K.Narayan, K.A. Abbas, Bhabani Bhattacharya etc. While Anand and Rao did it more obtrusively; Narayan and Abbas too bends the English language but very cleverly in their own way. The language is completely decolonised and is given national colour. Moreover, Salman Rushdie, one of the most articulate Diaspora writers of global fame, has spoken about his aesthetics at such diverse length. He observes that his predecessors have colonised and re-fashioned English in a way that had de-colonised the English language they have inherited from the British, and so does he. Entering the scene of Indian English novel with his '**Midnight's Children**', a book not about any one region but the whole sub continent, Rushdie uses English as a pan-Indian language and not as a regional language. Further, he uses many Hindi words without italicizing them. Thus, his fame tempered with Indian terms, writing in Pidgin and signalled a new term in writing that came to be known as '**Chutnification**'.

“Chutney” is a tangy India dish, adding flavour to the main course of any meal. “Chutney” is a noun form and is understood as such in English. By adding “-fication”, Rushdie changes an Indian word into an English one to stand for transformation. Therefore “Chutnification” means transformation of English having an additional connotation of making the language tangy and more flavoursome and exciting. He opened the doors to plethora of writers. And since 1981, when the Booker of the Bookers Book came out, Chutnification became viral.

‘Chutnification’ of English is the new ‘mantra’ of the day. Globalization has made the English language geographically and culturally proximate. Today, more and more vernacular and regional words are being incorporated into the English language. By way of general information, every year new edition of the renowned Oxford dictionary gets apprehended by a new list of words of Indian origin. Among roughly 359,000 words and phrases in the Oxford dictionary, about 700 words find their roots in some of the most ancient and notable Indian languages like Sanskrit and Hindi. To cite few examples: ‘masala’(a variety mix of spices), ‘dhaba’(open highway side eatery), ‘hawala’(illegal currency exchange), ‘bhajan’(a devotional song) etc. The most famous word of Indian origin today could indisputably be ‘Yoga’, owing to the global interest in this ancient art form. Literally, the word in Sanskrit means, “seamless integration of the mind, body and spirit”, the word has both literally and metamorphically affected tremendous integration in the global context. The word ‘Guru’ used in phrases like “language guru” or “get the Guru’s blessings” and the word ‘Dharma’ are used widely. A man’s ‘deeds’ is chutnified and its usage in its Indian equivalent is found in colloquial English. Words like ‘curry’ and ‘chutney’, ‘bungalow’ from ‘bungla’ and ‘pyjamas’ are all words of Indian origin that have Indianised the English language of the British.

For instance, the housemaid freely intersperses her vernacular communication with English words like: “Madam badi ‘fast’ gadi ‘drive’ kar rahi hai!!” Such Indianisms abound in plenty both in the colloquial and the written forms. A very common usage in India is of the generalised question tag: isn’t it? Repeating a word for emphasis: take,take; put,put; It was a small small box. However, more ‘chutnification’ is evident in words which are coined by joining a

component each from English and Hindi as in 'grameen bank'(village bank), 'lathi charge'(a charge using lathis), 'policewala'(a policeman), 'coconut paysam'(a sweet made of coconut) etc. The list of Indian idioms can be endless, but some that strikes my mind are: 'to sit on someone's neck' (to watch that person carefully) and 'to stand on someone's head' (supervise that person carefully). Apart from this, popular music of Hindi, Punjabi, Haryanvi, Bhojpuri etc has been a fertile ground for Chutnification. Also, chutnified titles have become an integral part of bollywood movies like- 'English Vinglish', 'Son of Sardar', 'Jab We Met', 'Bhootnath Returns' etc. Besides, Whatsapp, Facebook, Twitter etc are adding to the language more and more.

To conclude, it can be said, it is important for any language to have organic growth and constantly adapt itself to change. And the English language exhibits a flexibility to evolve and expand. As such, it became the language of the market. Moreover, as Indian, one feels both pride and happiness about the fact that India is the only country that seems to have added the spice and colour to the literary part of English dictionary as 'Chutnification'.

BENEFITS OF AGRICULTURE STUDY PROGRAM



Agriculture sector is an integral part of development and economic growth of a nation. Agriculture plays a key role in the economy of developing countries and provides food, income and job opportunities to a significant portion of population. The curriculum of Agriculture studies offers a wide range of learning and paves way to widespread opportunities to learners as professionals or entrepreneurs. Some of the agriculture core and allied areas that are designed in the curriculum are - Plant Sciences, Agronomy, Entomology, Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Extension and Communication, Genetics and Plant Breeding, Plant Pathology, Horticulture, Crop Modeling, Animal Sciences, Soil Science, Crop Physiology, Agricultural Engineering, Agro Forestry, Food Science, Seed Science and Technology, Agro Meteorology, Environmental Sciences, Microbiology, Floriculture, Vegetable Science, Production Techniques and Pest Management etc.

Agriculture study is a fine blend of classroom teaching and hands-on training at the field. Therefore, the teaching pedagogy is an excellent mix of these two aspects of learning. Students are made aware about the pedagogical tools at various stages of the program. Complete plan of teaching discourse is shared with the stakeholders and the faculty follows the teaching plan as per the schedule. The teaching pedagogy involves class room teaching, role plays, home and class assignments, lesson plan, field works at demonstration and regular fields, hands-on training etc. Keeping in view the consciousness and sensitization of students on various issues, the college ensures learning of students through various outreach programs too. National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of college leaves no stone unturned to meet the objectives laid through this program. The whole study programs has divided into different sections as per their outcomes:-

1. Case Studies exposure: *Case studies* provide live examples to the students from around the world demonstrating the best practices for sustainable *agriculture*. They provide evidence on farming practices in various ways. Case studies also demonstrate the dangers of excessive use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides in agriculture. Therefore, they understand sustainable organic agriculture practices too for achieving food security without harming the environment and public health.

2. *Emphasis on practical exposure:* Emphasis on practical exposure is much better than mere attaining the theoretical knowledge. The primary reason behind emphasizing upon the importance of practical learning is the kind of exposure students receive from such practices which helps them improve their skills. Here students can test their skills and help themselves to identify their weaknesses. This student-centered space enables learner-oriented assessment, where the design of the task is created for active student learning. Therefore, Practical exposure helps students to learn from self experiences which make them ready for the framework of the industry even before joining them.

3. *Inclusion of IT tools in teaching:* Various types of IT tools are used to support student learning. In present scenario, technology has taken a front seat and classrooms are well equipped with equipment and gadgets. Computers and mobiles are playing an important role in teaching- learning process. The use of open educational resources and other technologies are helping to increase educational productivity by accelerating the rate of learning, reducing costs associated with instructional materials or program delivery and better utilizing teacher time.

4. *Field/Live Projects:* Field work is one of the major important part in the field of Agriculture. A truly hands on training is given to the students in Practical Crop Production (PCP) in which students learn by doing the each and every step of crop production.

5. *Learning visits organized:* Our institute organizes learning visits of KVK, Industrial units, agriculture markets, Kisan Mela and various Agriculture institutes of repute. These visits are essential to give students hands on exposure and experience of how things work in industries. Such visits play a vital role to enhance students' exposure to practical learning in various domains.

6. *Guest Lectures:* To cater the present needs of industry we organize guest lectures, as part of lecture-series. How Far Technology be unified/ integrated in the ESL class room?

If you've been teaching ESL (English as a Second Language) for a while, you've probably observed some changes in how educational technology, or edtech, is employed. Tablets, gamification, virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), and customised learning, which were once uncommon, are becoming increasingly widespread. Students' expectations are also evolving. When looking up a new word, practically everyone uses their phone instead of a physical dictionary. They're also significantly more likely to conduct research online rather than visiting a library on the way home.

Some studies have found that it can help people learn languages faster. But it can also be disruptive, as any teacher who has had WiFi fail during a classroom quiz will tell you. “The finest or worst thing for education”, as Scott Widman pointed out in his TED Talk Technology. So, at this juncture, we'll talk about the positive and negative effects of technology in the classroom, as well as how to use edtech into your lessons.

When technology does not work together...

You're surely aware that any technical issue might disrupt a lesson's flow. The use of technology must be smooth. You don't want your students to be distracted by slow-loading pages, confusing interfaces, or mistakes.

So, the first consideration is whether the class will focus on learning or on getting the technology to work correctly.

Is the tech relevant to students?

The most famous example of classroom technology becoming disruptive is One Laptop Per Child (OLPC). Its objectives were ambitious which are to provide low-cost internet-connected computers to poor youngsters in order to help them access quality education. However, in certain places, things did not happen as planned in many countries.

‘WhatsApp’ made teaching and learning more accessible and allowed students to learn from anywhere with a mobile signal. Since young people are especially fond of using WhatsApp groups to talk to friends, there was no learning curve for them to join their English WhatsApp class.

They were able to work together to access learning materials, and also to support each other's learning. So let us use technology as a way to enhance our work as a teacher and the other materials we use, not as a replacement. Cambridge English Kahoots help teachers integrate fun, interactive games with their lessons. On the more academic, but still fun, side, Exam Lift is an enjoyable way for students to practise and improve their English. It focuses on all four language skills – reading, writing, listening and speaking and offers in-app exam practice. Eventually, I would say that the importance of educational technology is only going to increase as teachers and students learn how best to make it work.

 For the whole world.

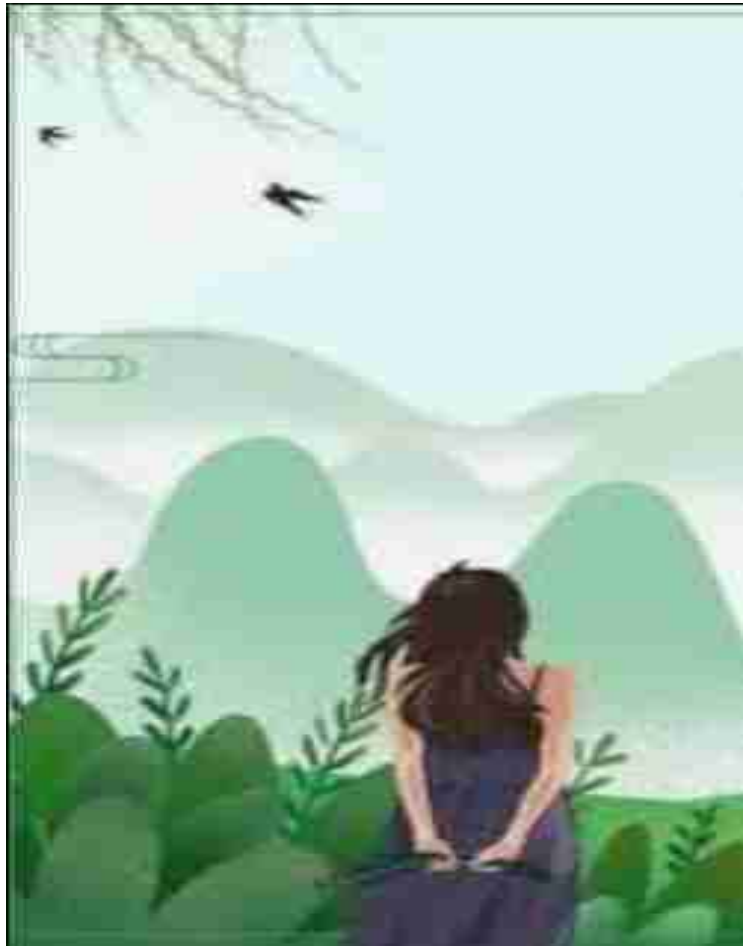
