Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) replaces the Indian Penal Code; the Bharatiya Sakshya (BS) replaces the Indian Evidence Act; and the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) replaces the Code of Criminal Procedure. The BNS is a transformative judicial reform based on victim centric approach, providing witness protection and aims at fast and speedy delivery of justice with the use of technology etc. In this regard, flyers are being shared for use by HEIs for creating a sensitization amongst faculty and students about the BNS and its implications for ensuring timely justice.
