They will be able to identify key movements, shifts, and historical milestones.

They will also understand the structure of poetry — through the study of prosody (chhanda) — like Matrabritta and Aksharbritta. Figures of speech (Alankar), such as simile (Upama), metaphor (Rupak), will be studied to enhance literary appreciation.

Students will be able to read and analyze Bengali texts deeply — not just at the surface level. They will develop critical tools to understand themes, narrative techniques, characterizations, symbols, and literary styles, thereby interpreting the texts thoughtfully.
